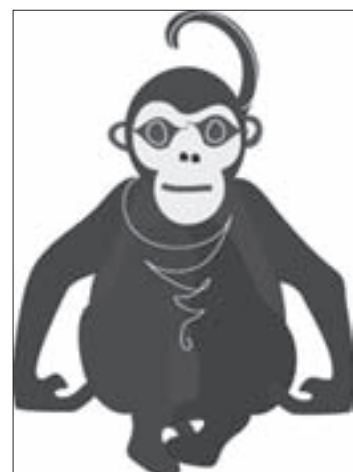

## Parol Parade Held at Filipinotown

LOS ANGELES—The Historic Filipinotown Neighborhood Council recently held a Christmas lantern parade from Manila Terrace to the Search to Involve Pilipino Americans (SIPA) youth and community center on Dillon and Temple St. Some 600 youth received donated gifts at the holiday party. Families who are tenants of Sacatela and Normandie Villages and Magnolia on Lake enjoyed the food and entertainment.

Dr. Ben Marte of the Pilipino Americans for Networking and Advocacy (PANA) was the Santa Claus of the night.

Joel Jacinto, SIPA executive director said that the parol parade and the family get together of the holidays is an annual event of SIPA to reach out to the youth and families in the area.

"We want to extend our cheers to many children as part of our mission to promote harmony in the family. Many of our donors realize that in this season, the children look up to the joy of receiving toys and presents which is representative of the values that SIPA inculcates among the youth—the human spirit of generosity and benevolence. We also welcome everyone in our effort to promote community participation and involvement," Jacinto said.

Leo Pandac, SIPA board vice president stressed that the parol which originated from the Spanish word, "farol" or lantern symbolizes light. Essentially, SIPA seeks to be the light which will guide many families in empowering themselves in the community.

"The parol parade is one traditional effort for cultural identity and to hone the creativity of the youth to come up with artistic lanterns which does not really hold no ethnic boundaries. SIPA encourages the preservation of culture and multicultural understanding. This way we are able to achieve unity in diversity," Pandac said.

The parol parade and competition was organized by the Historic Filipinotown Neighborhood Council, SIPA, PANA, Pacific Asian Drug and Alcohol Program and Filipino American Library.
