If we hold on the little positives in our everyday lives, I have a feeling we're going to pull through these tough times quite famously.

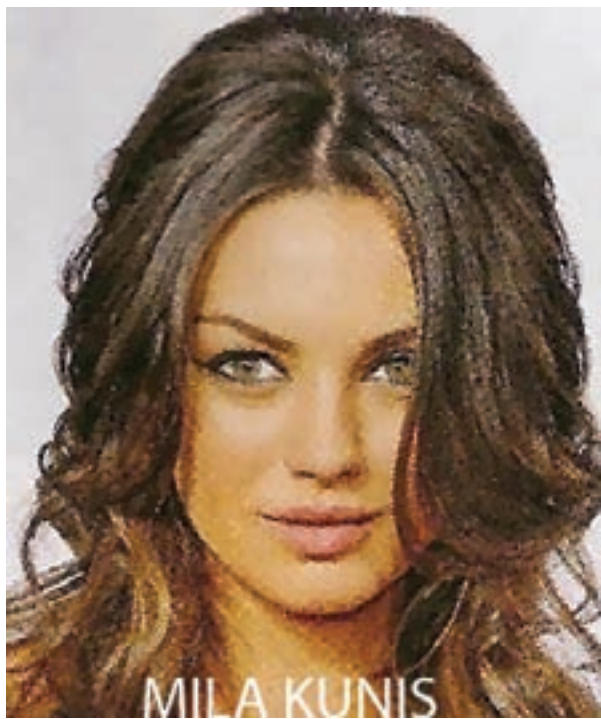
