A whole army ready to fight for the 'Tribute to the Oscars' photo exhibit The coverboys is the platoon to scream for

THE movie that got a "one of the best war films ever made" remark from the critics conquered your feisty eyes in the *Tribute to Oscars Exhibit* which was unveiled at the Ayala Museum on the 20th of February.



Winner of four Academy Awards in the year 1986 (Academy Best Picture, Best Director, Best Editing, and Best Sound), the movie *Platoon* surely satisfied the audience with its invigorating and dramatic depiction of the raging war between the Vietcong and the Americans. Over-the-top photographer Raymund Isaac, stylist Sidney Yap, and the hottest male group today, the Coverboys teamed up for a photo shoot that justifies the splendid yet vicious lives of the soldiers during the war.

The Coverboys, composed of Jake Cuenca, Rafael Rossell, Victor Basa, Jon Avila, Will Devaughn, Ron Morales, John James Uy, and Marvin Raymundo said that they are very much excited to take on this shoot since *The Platoon* is a great movie. As a matter of fact, the all-male group has been looking forward to and talking about

the unique yet fascinating photo shoot all week. *The Godfather* fan Jake Cuenca stressed that their advantage as a team was their photographer himself, "Raymund is our edge. His artistry is our edge."

Stylist Sidney Yap said theirs is the only group who'll have not one, but eight individuals that will take part in the photo shoot and sees this opportunity as a challenge and at the same time is excited to see the end result of all their hard work. *The Moulin Rouge* fan furthered that the concept of the shoot is to illustrate through pictures the lives of the soldiers, during and in-between wars.

"I think there's going to be more drama because we're going to do it a little more journalistic. It's like a peepshow to what happens in between war. Like their downtime when they're thinking about home and they're not actually at war."

Renowned fashion photographer Raymund Isaac was honest about the fact that he never loved war images - since he was known for beauty, glamour, sexy shots - and this was according to him, a challenge.

"I will try to do what Raymund Isaac will do given the limitations of what we have. I don't have the same visuals as the movie. It's with the limited vision of the actors and models and how it will affect us. So we'll see from there," he said.
